MONDAY 20 <sup>th</sup> JULY	<p><b>Dave's Rave : THE NUANCES OF REGULATION....."OVER" REGULATION..... and DYSFUNCTIONAL, INSURANCE DRIVEN STUPIDITY!</b></p> <p>Sadly, our industry is at the top of the heap when it comes to the five “P’s” of government strategies. We are seen as a <b>POLITICAL PLAYGROUND</b> for <b>POPULARIST POLICIES</b> and <b>PROMISES</b> to buy your votes! Great for governments ...not so great for our children and their childhood!</p> <p>The childcare world exists in a tangled web of regulatory authority, administered by both Federal and State departments, creating and enforcing multi levels of rules and regulation in what can only be described as “<b>desperation governance</b>” to appease the all-consuming spectre of insurance driven risk!!</p> <p><b>The promise we were sold: REGULATION</b> - the establishment of a functional set of consistent guidelines to best practices that blend long established traditions with modern innovations to nurture positive interactions and relationships between all participants i.e. children, parents, childcare professionals and authorities alike!</p> <p><b>The reality we got: OVER-REGULATION</b> – The placement of the OOSH sector, with its “Middle Childhood” aged children, aged 5-13 years, living daily under the governance of the Education Department, into the realms of the Early Childhood Directorate to follow inappropriate rules and regulations designed for 0–5-year-olds. A prime example is staff/child ratios. Education Dept school classroom 1:30, OOSH classroom 1:15. Education Dept school playground 1:70, OOSH playground 1:15.</p> <p><b>The quagmire that exists today: DYSFUNCTIONAL, INSURANCE DRIVEN STUPIDITY!</b> Everyday games, activities and learning experiences that were a necessary rite of passage in the past are now over analysed, overregulated and overshadowed by a prohibitive neurosis of “insurance driven” policy and the genuflection to the all-powerful God of <b>RISK!</b> Add to this the overlaying culture and threat of fines and fear instilled into the industry by bureaucracy, they become too hard and people just stop doing them!</p> <p>The concept of discipline, structure and consequences for behaviours and actions are again over analysed, overregulated and overshadowed in the same way and have fallen by the wayside! This is typified by the way childcare workers are being trained to stand around in little yellow vests all day, taking notes on the way that, “<b>Johnny broke 3 toys today using his left hand!</b>” in order to satisfy departmental documentation regulations! Sadly, no thought is given to, nor are they allowed by law, intervening and <b>STOPPING</b> Johnny from smashing the toys and give him a consequence. In our current incarnation, the world of childcare is being demonised by political voices to cover up for their inadequacies of the day-to-day operation of systems put in place to keep children safe. The governments knee jerk solution has been to create a whole new tier of regulations, policed by a newly created regulatory body, whose purpose is to regulate the regulators that didn't regulate properly in the first place!
